Information on demonstrating proof of English language proficiency for the Bachelor's degree programme 'International Business Administration'

Students seeking admission to the B.A. programme 'International Business Administration' must demonstrate that they have a sufficiently good command of the English language.

Proof must be provided to *htw saar* by no later than 15 July of the year in which the applicant is seeking admission.

- (1) Students can demonstrate proof of proficiency in English by:
 - a) submitting the results of a recognized, external language test, or by
 - b) passing the internal language assessment tests run by the Business School, or by
 - c) presenting an official document that demonstrates that English is the applicant's native language

or

- d) by providing confirmation from a state-recognized university that in gaining his or her first degree, the applicant has already achieved the required number of ECTS credits for the relevant foreign language (English) as set out in the relevant annex to the General Study and Examination Regulations issued by *htw saar*.
- (2) Applicants can also demonstrate their proof of proficiency in English by submitting the results of a recognized, external language test (such as TOEFL or IELTS).
 - For Bachelor's degree courses, the minimum required proficiency is **level B2** of the Common European Framework.
 - On the application deadline, the test certificate must **not be more than two years old** as determined by its date of issue.

Applicants can take the tests free of charge. It is not necessary to register for the test. You will, however, be required to present your personal ID or your driving licence. You will be notified of the results of the test in good time before the application deadline (15 July).
