Selected lectures in English & company visits

- By exploring current topics with industry experts and htw saar professors, you will get up-to-date sneak peaks into German engineering and management from the German perspective. There are six intensive lectures offered during the three weeks of summer immersion.
- You will discover world leading companies in our region through interactive tours. These include global players such as Festo, Hager, Villeroy & Boch, ZF and Michelin. Students will have the possibility to get an insight into German and European business and corporate culture.



German language & intercultural communication

- In addition to the lectures and company visits, you will benefit from an intensive German language course consisting of ten teaching hours per week

Learn about work-specific vocabulary and related topics.

- You will dive into the German working culture in a dense course of four teaching hours per week. You will focus on work and business cultures like organizational and team cultures frequently found in German companies and be introduced to the basics of communication cultures in professional and private environments. Our approach is learner-centred and follows effective training methods.



Summer Immersion program scope

- Every week the summer immersion program consists of 20 hours (6 of lectures, 10 hours of German, 4 hours of intercultural communication). The 3-week program is in total worth 5 ECTS (European credit transfer system), and additionally includes company visits and extracurricular activities.
- Lectures will be held in English, German intensive classes on your respective level - and of course, various activities like sightseeing, sports, cultural evenings and a local BBQ will be offered, too!
- htw saar student tutors will support summer immersion participants, help with practical questions and link the course to the local student community.

A day trip to the city of Heidelberg, including a picnic in a parc and wonderful sights of the town!

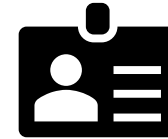


Other activities included in the program

Costs and accommodation



- program fee of 480€, including: all lectures and classes, all leisure activities and excursions provided by the program, a ticket for public transportation within the city limits



**No program fee for participants
from partner universities!**



- Accommodation and travel expenses are to be paid privately by the participants.
- The summer school team offers to help by booking a room at a special rate in a local city hotel for the participants at the rate of 55€/night (to be paid by the participants), but participants are free to look for accommodation on their own (e.g. AirBnB, booking.com, wg-gesucht.de or elsewhere).
