About htw saar and the city of Saarbrücken

- The Hochschule für Technik und Wirtschaft des Saarlandes (University of Applied Sciences, htw saar) in Saarbrücken is situated in the South-West of Germany close to the border of France and Luxemburg.
- The university (with currently about 6000 students) offers more than 45 fulltime and part time degree programmes on four main campuses in Saarbrücken and the greater region. The Business School with more than 2300 students is one of the largest school of htw saar with a vibrant international student community.
- Study programmes are highly structured with students often learning in small groups. Excellent supervision and close contact to the academic staff are distinctive features of academic life at htw saar. The university places considerable emphasis on high-quality, practically-focused teaching that is closely meshed with real social, business and industrial applications.
- Being located in the center of the so-called Saar-Lor-Lux triangle, Saarland is strongly influenced by its neighbors France and Luxembourg. This makes its state capital Saarbrücken a unique, open minded and student oriented city located in the heart of Europe. With a population of 180 000 it is one of the smaller of Germany's major cities. Saarbrücken boasts an attractive old town and varied cultural and recreational amenities.

- Cost for accommodation and living and travel expenses have to be covered by the guest students themselves.
