

Bus & Tram in Saarbrücken

Bus and tram (Saarbahn) connections can be found on this website: www.saarfahrplan.de.

There is also an app called "Saarfahrplan". You can buy tickets directly from the bus driver or from the machine at the tram stop. A single trip within Saarbrücken costs 2.60€, a day ticket 5.80 €. With a valid semester ticket from htw saar, travel within Saarland is free.

Arrival at Saarbrücken Central Station (Saarbrücken Hbf)

The bus stop at the train station is called "Saarbrücken Hauptbahnhof". From here you can take the bus or tram (called "Saarbahn") to almost anywhere in the city.

1. To get to the htw Saar Campus-Alt Saarbrücken, it is best to take the bus 124 from the train station to the HTW / SWS stop, without having to change the bus.
2. To get to the htw Saar Campus Rotenbühl (CRB), it is best to take the bus 124 from the train station to the "Waldhaus, Saarbrücken" bus stop, without having to change the bus.

You can simply enter the stops on the website or app mentioned above and you will receive all available connections, including bus numbers and transfer options.

If you want to go to your hotel or apartment first

On the above mentioned [website](#), you can also find out about the connections to your hotel or apartment in Saarbrücken. All you need to do is find out the name of the bus stop (hotels usually have it on their website). You then enter this into the website to find the connection.
